Veeramani case: 2 IPS officers shunted out

Two senior IPS officers who were at the helm of the Chennai Police Commissionerate when a complaint accusing Gem Granites owner Veeramani of indulging in predatory sexual behaviour targeting minor girls first surfaced were removed from their posts on Thursday.

Additional Chief Secretary (Home) K. Manivasan said in an order that A. Arun, ADGP, Tamil Nadu Police Academy, and N. Kannan, Commissioner of Police, Coimbatore, were being transferred with immediate effect and placed on compulsory wait.

The order did not specify reasons for their transfer. But the development came against the backdrop of Tamil Nadu Congress Committee Scheduled Caste department leader Ranjan Kumar revealing that as early as November 2024, he had given a complaint about the crime to Mr. Kannan when he was the Additional Commissioner of Police, Chennai.

Mr. Kumar said the officer had told him that he would deal with the complaint after conferring with Mr. Arun, the then Commissioner of Police.

However, only last year did the police register a First Information Report (FIR) in the case, claiming that they had received an anonymous letter and pen drive (allegedly containing evidence of the sexual abuse) through a representative of a non-governmental organisation.

According to the Home Department order, DGP (Training) Rajeev Kumar will hold the additional charge of the Police Academy and R.V. Ramya Bharati, IGP, West Zone, will hold the additional charge of Commissioner of Police, Coimbatore.

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T.N. claims Cauvery shortfall, Karnataka points to 'drought'

Tamil Nadu says it is suffering from a deficit of 20,000 tmc ft of river water while Karnataka says it did its best to comply with water disbursement responsibilities; T.N. claims kharif crop affected

The Supreme Court on Thursday sought Karnataka's response to a plea by Tamil Nadu that it is suffering from a shortfall of 20 thousand million cubic feet of Cauvery river water.

Karnataka, in turn, submitted in the top court that it was facing a "terrible drought situation" and has complied, to the best, its responsibilities towards Tamil Nadu as an upper riparian State.

Appearing before a Bench headed by Justice Vikram Nath, both State governments concurred on the point that the Cauvery water was a "very sensitive" issue for them.

"Karnataka is usurping all the water, depriving us of our own," senior advocate C.S. Vaidyanathan submitted for Tamil Nadu. Senior advocate Shyam Divan, for Karnataka, said entire districts in the State have been declared as drought-prone.

"Yet, we have taken it on the chin and done our best to comply," he submitted.

The court gave Karnataka a week to file its response while scheduling the next hearing on October 12. Mr. Vaidyanathan, accompanied by senior advocate G. Umaphathy, complained that both the Cauvery Water Regulation Committee (CWRC) and the Cauvery Water Management Authority (CWMA) have not addressed the deficit of Cauvery water due to Tamil Nadu from Karnataka.

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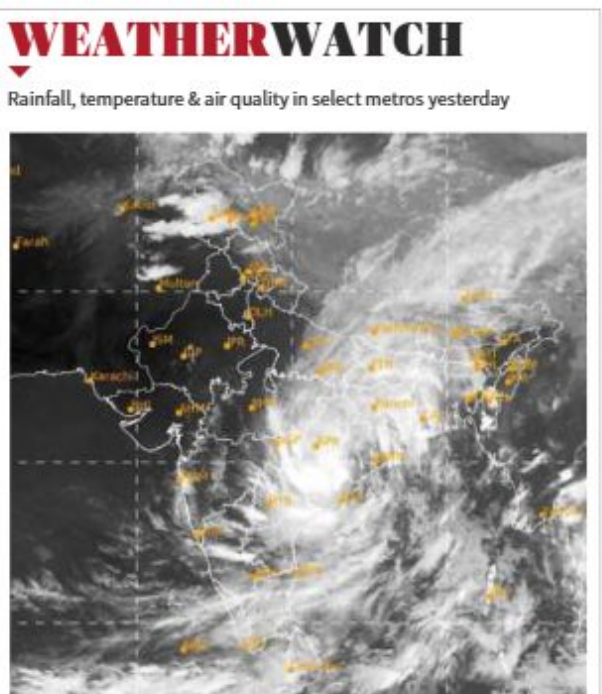
